The Pavers

You may choose a 6" X 6" or 6" X 9" brick to be located in one of our three areas. There is a maximum of three lines of text on either size brick. The larger bricks can accommodate 15 characters per line and the smaller brick, 10 characters per line. Spaces count as a character.

Pavers in the entrance area will be most visible. These bricks may be engraved with a name and/or a short message.

The Reading Garden is the largest area where the engraved pavers will be located. These bricks can be engraved with a choice of a name and message or a favorite book or author.

The Flagpole area is intended to serve as a memorial to members of the United States Armed Forces. These bricks can be engraved with "In honor of" or "In memory of".
