Services offered at the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library:

*For individuals who **CANNOT** leave their homes to come to the Library:*

- The Library will provide delivery and pick-up of materials.
- The outreach librarian will check out all material for you and receive all returned material.
- You need a valid library card and must be designated as being part of the outreach program.
- If you don't have a library card, you can fill out an application form and write "outreach" on top.

*For individuals who **CAN** come to the Library:*

- You can request a particular book by calling the Library at 518-371-8622 and asking to speak with a librarian.
- If the book isn't immediately available, we can place a hold request to get a copy for you.
- We will notify you either by a phone call or an email when the book is available for pick-up.
- We hold books for five days after you are notified so you don't have to come in the same day to pick it up.
